To maintain clean and green campus has been the top agenda of our institute. College has a green campus and gives priority to keep the <u>campus clean and eco friendly</u>. The solid waste management is classified as degradable and non degradable wastes. For the degradable solid waste management we have open composting and <u>Vermin composting unit</u>. Solid waste is collected in dustbins kept at several places. The leaf litter, twigs of the plants used for practical in Botany department are collected and subjected to composting. Vermin compost is harvested and used for plants as manure in campus garden. Non degradable waste contains building debris, plastic, glass, metal scrap etc. Recyclable plastic, glass waste, metal scrap is sold to scrap merchant and Building debris is used for land filling in the campus.

E-waste management- E-waste generated is collected and stored in the store room. All collected waste has been sold to authorized vender.

Hazardous chemicals and radioactive waste management – No Radioactive waste is generated in the campus.

Now being that the second party is a client, this Agreement witnesses the following terms & conditions to be performed by both the parties to the

 The First Party has agreed to pick up, transport, carry and recycle/dispose
of the E-waste from the Second Party as per the norms prescribed by the ent Authorities from time to time

- 2. The First Party has agreed to make available Utilization Certificate confirming that E-waste provided by the Second Party to the First Party has been recycledifferended of as por the none prescribed by the Government Authorities withing 60 days of the pickup the E-waste.
 8. The Second Party will also required documents to acknowledge that E-waste has been handed over to the First Party.

- The First Party Shall install an <u>E-waste Collection Bin</u> of Size <u>Taster(L)x0.9meter (D) x 0.8 meter (W)</u> at location as may be prescribed by The Second Party has agreed to pay an 'agreement fee' of B4.500 /- +
- 18%GST annually to the first party as fee for the contract. Total of <u>@ 22,590 /-</u>
 + 18%GST to be paid one time in advance Rent for 5 years of the E-waste Bin
- 7. The Second Party will accumulate all E-waste and inform to the first party once reasonable volunte (approx. 100 kg aminimum) has accumulated. The pickups confirmed by the Second Party will be carried out on a priority basis within Five sky from the date of request.
 8. The Second Party has agreed to landover the E-waste items, the dealts of which are mentioned here below to the First Party or "as in where it basis." The First Party or "as in where it basis." The First Party will dispose of such equipment and specifically agreed that they will

 9. The Second Party has agreed to handover the E-waste, the details of which are mentioned here below to The First Party on "as in where is basis".

- 10. The First Party will pay in case of the E-waste after inspection. Any money payable/receivable by the First Party will be identified and settled by 2th of preceding month for the current month or the subsequent month as may be musually decided from time to time.  11. The Second Party's responsibility will cease once electronic waste has been handed over to the First Party. Thereafter, no liability would accrue to the Second Party on account of e-waste.

 12. The renewal of the contract is non-chargeafte at the end of the temperature of the descentation formalities shall be done by the First Party within 30-45 days prior to the date of agreement termination.

 13. Records & data of the e-waste material procured will be maintained and transparently shared by the First Party.

 14. The First Party shall provide compliance documents such as Firm. 6 (manifest) and Recycling Certificate/proposed as pre poverment forms.

 15. The Second Party shall provide that the grared waste such as manifestian shall start will not be inclined in the L-waste.

 16. It is clearly agreed that all the E-waste procured by or in the procession of the Second Party will be exclusively managed by the First Party as per the error and conditions specified above. In easi or shas sharily, an annual penuity of Rs. 5000 will be charged on a pro-trat basis.

 17. The First Party shall conduct an "Awareness Secsions" at the promises suggested by and in collaboration with the "Second Party" for generating awareness about the berefits and process of ewaste recycling.

 18. Either party can terminate this Agreement by giving 45 days written to the other party (sing reasonable grounds for such browner, the other party is not entitled to cleim any compensation for such premature termination if with reasonable sufficient grounds.
